

"Unadilla - a Place of Meeting"

Unadilla was platted in 1871 along the Midland Pacific Railway, which entered the state at Nebraska City and continued west through Unadilla and points beyond...



These connected buildings were designed as Unadilla's "Main Street Historic District" and placed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The district is visually and architecturally dominated by the First National Bank building. It and the adjacent
